## INSTRUCTIONS FOR PLANK REPLACEMENT

**If you wish to replace a wood plank that has been worn without having to totally renovate your floor, you can easily do so, by following the instructions below:**

1: By using a circular saw, cut 1 - 3 holes (depending on the plank's width) on the small edges of the plank and connect them by a length-wise cut, using a tongue & groove cutter. Always make sure that you estimate correctly the depth of the cut, which depends on the thickness of the plank.

2: Remove the plank from the floor, by using a crowbar or a long screwdriver as lever.

3: From the new plank remove the lower part of the groove (length-wise and width-wise) and of the tongue (only width-wise) with a tongue & groove cutter.

4: Apply and spread adhesive CLASS D3 at the remaining part of the plank (length-wise & width-wise). Install the plank by inserting the tongue side into the groove that is waiting on the floor.

**ATTENTION: Only planks that have been installed nailed or floating can be removed.**
